
Introduction

- The StART Talking Week ran from Monday 21st to Friday 25th October 2019.
- There were 892 responses in total;
 - 480 positive (53.8%)
 - 175 neutral (19.6%)
 - 237 negative responses (26.6%)
- Main categories of feedback were;
 - 213 responses on 'Teaching on the Course' (24%)
 - 115 responses on 'Course & Learning Content' (13%)
- The Business and Law Faculty had the most responses (30%).



Overall University Feedback



Overall University Feedback by Category














Creative and Cultural Industries 58 responses






Creative and Cultural Industries by Category 58 responses





Humanities and Social Sciences by Category







ICP by Category









Technology by Category



Comment Trends - BAL

The most frequent positive themes were:

Course Content - 32

1.1. The comments show general satisfaction with the course content, particularly modules that are designed to stand out in job applications and provide opportunities to work with real businesses. The availability of lecture materials through recording lectures and publishing powerpoints was also praised.

2. **Teaching Staff** - 25

2.1. Praise for staff members who are very responsive to students' issues and questions and work with the students to improve the course / module. Further praise for staff who are enthusiastic about their content and who offer constructive, proactive feedback.

3. **Library** - 17

3.1. This mainly referred to the wide range of resources available, the library staff being friendly and helpful, as well as the 24/7 access to the library.



Comment Trends - BAL

The most frequent negative themes were:

1. Course Organisation - 23

1.1. Comments identified a lack of guidance for independent study. Some comments refer to the change in teaching terms, saying that the increase of modules per term affects the ability to manage time efficiently, while having the same content taught within a shorter period of time leads to decreasing concentration and increasing stress due to more assessments.

2. Assessments & Feedback - 18

2.1. This mainly referred to a need for clarity in assessment requirements as well as more guidance and support offered prior to the deadlines.

3. **Teaching staff** - 17

3.1. This mainly referred to a need for some teaching staff to be more approachable and open to questions from students.

Comment Trends - CCI

The most frequent positive themes were:

- Course Content 13
 - 1.1. The comments showed general satisfaction with the course content, particular praise for content that is interesting and helpful, as well as practical.
- 2. **Teaching Staff** 12
 - 2.1. Positive comments referring to staff being friendly and responsive to queries, as well as informed and professional in teaching. Particular praise for staff who strive to make lectures interactive and engaging with students throughout.

Comment Trends - CCI

The most frequent negative themes were:

- 1. Course Organisation 9
 - 1.1. Some comments refer to modules content being repetitive, which leads to decreased attendance, and identify a need to shift the focus from theory to practical solutions. Additionally, the feedback shows a need for more information on work placements opportunities.
- 2. Union and Societies 5
 - 2.1. Comments mention the closure of Waterhole Bar and identify a need for more diverse student groups.

Comment Trends - HSS

The most frequent positive themes were:

- 1. **Teaching Staff** 23
 - 1.1. Comments generally praised teaching staff who are supportive, knowledgeable and keen to make the content engaging and practical. There were positive examples of students feeling supported and encouraged by the teaching staff.
- 2. Course Content 21
 - 2.1. This mainly referred to students enjoying their course and finding it useful and interesting. Particular praise to the diversity in module options and opportunities for practical experience.
- 3. **Library** 7
 - 3.1. Overall positive comments about the library and resources available, such as wide range of books available, silent areas for study and the references webpage.



Comment Trends - HSS

The most frequent negative themes were:

1. Course Organisation - 13

1.1. Comments contained mentions of timetabling issues at the beginning of the term and identified a need for more contact time between staff and students. There was also mention of the recent change which saw modules condensed into one term as having a negative impact on studies and having lacked consultation with students.

2. Assessments & Feedback - 10

2.1. This mainly referred to a need for more support and guidance on upcoming deadlines as well as more detailed feedback.

3. University Building Facilities - 7

3.1. Comments mention food options being expensive and lacking diversity, need for more study spaces during busy times as well as ensured accessibility for students with mobility needs.

Comment Trends - SAH

The most frequent positive themes were:

- 1. Course Content 19
 - 1.1. General positive comments, describing content as informative, interesting and useful. Particular praise to courses which are focused on practical learning such as workshops and prepare for future jobs.
- 2. **Teaching staff** 16
 - 2.1. Overall positive feedback about teaching staff; comments praise staff members who are very responsive both in writing and in person and keen to improve the course by listening to students' views.
- 3. **Societies** 14
 - 3.1. Comments praise the opportunities to socialise and make friends in societies, as well as their diversity and inclusivity.



Comment Trends - SAH

The most frequent three negative themes were:

- 1. Assessments & Feedback 16
 - 1.1. This mainly referred to assessments, particularly exams, which are too close together and thus impact negatively on preparation potential and performance, as well as lead to stress and pressure.
- 2. Course Organisation 16
 - 2.1. This mainly referred to a need for better communication of changes within the course and keeping Moodle updated and structured.
- 3. Union & Societies 10
 - 3.1. This mainly referred to the closure of the Waterhole Bar and memberships to sports societies being too expensive.

Comment Trends - TEC

The most frequent positive themes were:

- 1. Course content 31
 - 1.1. The comments show general satisfaction with the course content, students enjoying the course and finding it interesting and useful.
- 2. **Teaching staff** 27
 - 2.1. Praise for staff members who are supportive and responsive to students' questions, as well as knowledgeable and with previous experience in the field. Comments also mention staff being approachable and keen to make lectures engaging.
- 3. **Library** 13
 - 3.1. This mainly referred to easy access around the library, good range of resources and spaces, particularly the quiet areas for individual learning.

Comment Trends - TEC

The most frequent negative themes were:

- 1. Course Organisation 20
 - 1.1. Comments identify a need to have some courses more organised from the beginning of the academic year to avoid confusion as well as utilising Moodle more effectively in informing students of changes and updates.
- 2. Union & Societies 11
 - 2.1. This mainly referred to feedback and the need for more detailed, tailored feedback with focus on areas for improvement.
- 3. Assessments & Feedback 10
 - 3.1. This mainly referred to the closure of Waterhole Bar and need for more social space and activities.
